

BOND in (Rs.21/- Non-judicial paper)

{To be executed by the candidate at the time of taking admission into Under Graduate (M.B.B.S.) course in Government Medical Colleges of the State of Odisha}

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT WE, _____
Son/daughter/wife of _____ aged about _____ years, resident of _____, P.O. _____, P.S. _____ in the district of _____ at present admitted to M.B.B.S. Course in SRM MCH, Bhawanipatna, Kalahandi (*here in after called the "principal obligor"*) and Shree/Smt. _____ aged about _____ years, Son/daughter/wife of _____ aged about _____ years, resident of _____, P.O. _____, P.S. _____ in the district of _____ at present employed as _____ in the Office/Department of _____ (*here in after called "surety No.1"*) and Shree/Smt. _____ aged about _____ years, Son/daughter/wife of _____ aged about _____ years, resident of _____, P.O. _____, P.S. _____ in the district of _____ at present employed as _____ in the Office/Department of _____ (*here in after called "surety No.2"*) do hereby jointly & severally bind ourselves and our respective heirs, executors and administrators and legal representative to pay the Governor of Odisha, his successors and assigns (*hereinafter called "the Government"*), on demand the amount of Rs.25,00,000.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five lakhs) only that the Government will incur on account of the Principal obligor having been placed on M.B.B.S. Course till completion of the said course.

WHEREAS the above principal obligor is placed on admission into M.B.B.S. Course and admissible by the Government;

AND WHEREAS for better protection of the healthcare of the Government in the State, the Principal obligor has agreed to execute this bond with such condition as hereunder written;

AND WHEREAS the said surety has agreed to execute this bond as surety for the discharge of the above burden of Rs.25,00,000.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five lakhs) only by the Principal obligor _____.

NOW THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN BOND is that in the event of successful learning and completion of M.B.B.S. course and obtaining registration there of the Principal obligor _____ is to render 2 (two) years of service in the State of Odisha. In case the Principal obligor fails to comply due to any reason, the Principal obligor is liable for refund of an amount Rs.25,00,000.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five lakhs) only to the Government of Odisha.

Appointment under the State Government after successful completion of M.B.B.S. Course shall mean and include regular appointment through O.P.S.C. or *adhoc* appointment or contractual appointment etc. Once an appointment (anyone of the above type) is given, the candidate shall have to join within 30 days from the date of receipt of the appointment order failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs.25,00,000.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five lakhs) only.

Further in the event of leaving the course due to any reason before the completion of MBBS /BDS Course, leading to lapse of a seat, the Principal Obligor is liable for refund of an amount of 10.00 lakhs (Rupees ten lakhs) to the Government of Odisha.

AND UPON in Principal obligor _____ and _____ & _____ the sureties as aforesaid making such refund, the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue and it is agreed and declared by the Principal obligor and the sureties that in the event of default without prejudice to other remedies that the Government may adopt, the Government shall be entitled to recover the aforesaid amount from the Principal obligor and the Sureties jointly and severally in the form of public demand under the Odisha Public Demand Recovery Act, 1962.

Save and except death, permanent disability or selection for higher study under no circumstances, the Principal obligor can forgo the appointment and posting and if it so happens he shall be liable to refund the money amount to Rs.25,00,000.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five lakhs) only.

PROVIDED that the liability of the surety hereunder shall not be impaired or discharged by reason of time being granted by the Government or by any forbearance, act or omission on the part of the Government or any person authorized by it (wherever with or without the consent or knowledge of the surety nor shall it be necessary for the Government to sue the said Principal obligor before suing the above bounded sureties _____ and _____ on any of them for the amount due hereunder);

Provided further that, in case of selection for higher study this bond will be seized to be operative till the study is completed and will be deemed to be in force on the date of completion of higher study and accordingly, all the above mentioned clauses will be in operation for all purposes.
